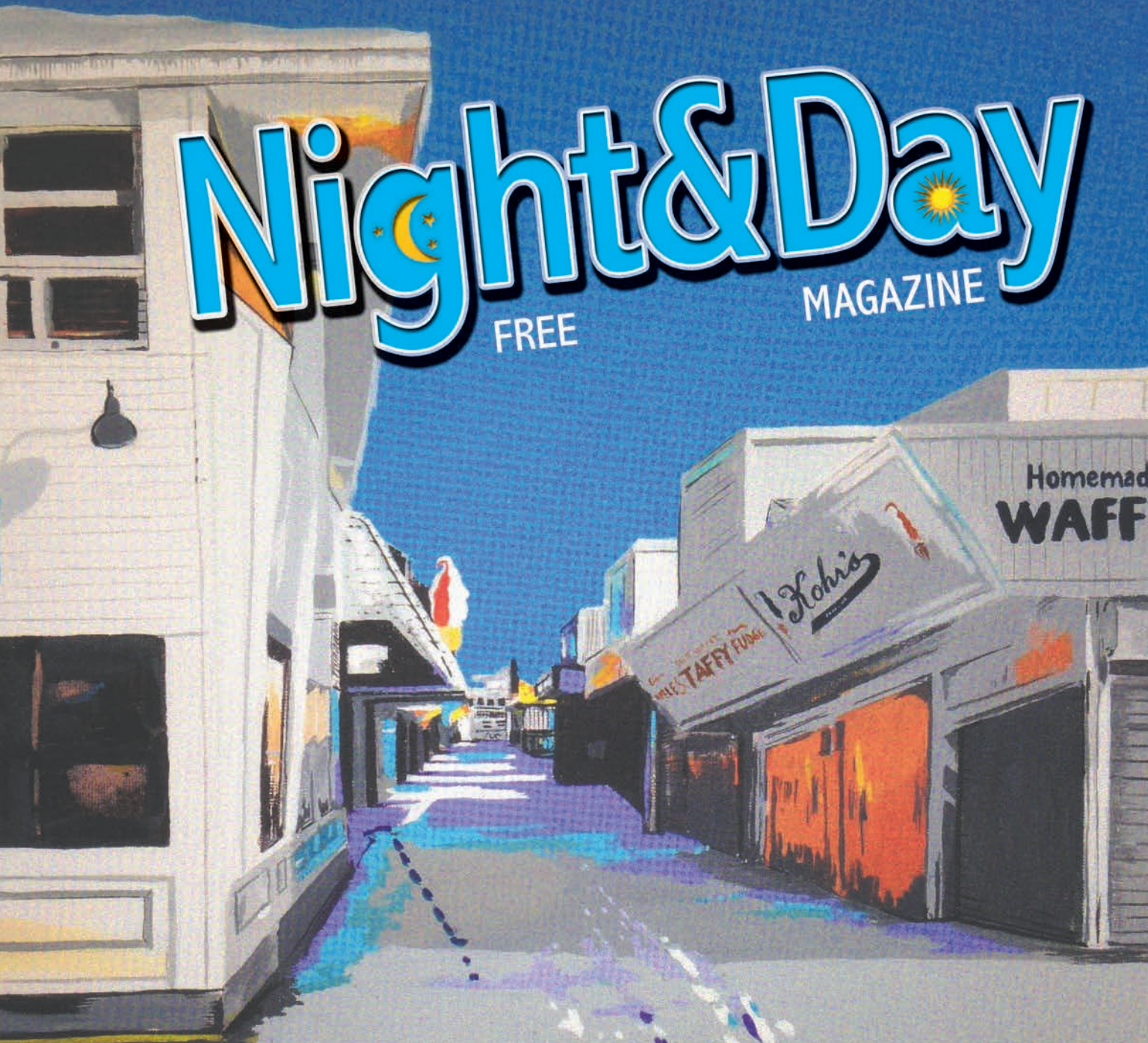

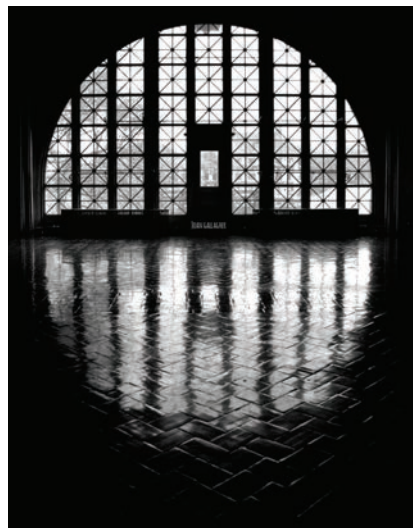

2018 Winner Cover Art Contest **JOAN** GALLAGHER

Behind the lens, in front of the canvas

Sometimes one’s passion takes the form of a hobby or even a career, and in other cases that passion is as much a part of the person as anything else. For Joan Gallagher that passion is art and it has been a constant in her life for as long as she can remember.

MEET OUR WINNER

Gallagher went to school to be an artist, but that is hardly the first time art was at the forefront of her life.

“In fact I still even have the little picture from kindergarten that I won for doing art, it’s really funny,” said Gallagher with a laugh.

For the artist — who paints, draws, practices photography and has done calligraphy — art is basically whatever she can get her hands on.

“It’s something I’ve always just loved and if I’m not drawing or painting or doing photog-

raphy then I’m miserable,” she said. “You know, I have to do it. It’s just part of who I am.”

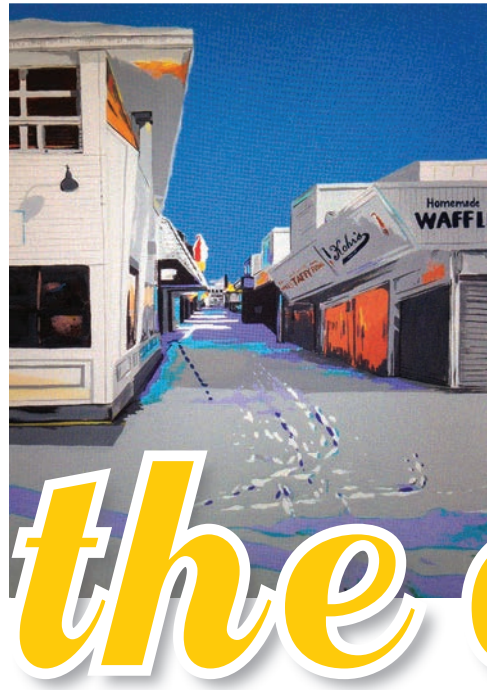
According to Gallagher, she worked in watercolors for years, but as soon as she switched over to digital, she started to really find the perfect medium. She found a way to combine three things that she loved into one: painting, photography and computer editing.

Gallagher explains that she will take a photograph and put it on the computer and change up the color to as bright as she wants, admitting that she loves color. Once she gets the colors exactly as she wants them she’ll do a painting of her new image.

Her passion for photography led her to join a photography group in which over 125 members get together at various places and shoot whatever they see. Gallagher then will come home from these social meetups and do paintings of the photographs she took.

The group currently has an exhibit in Middletown Arts Center and Gallagher was allowed to enter some of her paintings into the show, as well. Photography and painting have gone hand in hand throughout her artwork.

“When I look at photos sometimes I look at them just as a photo, but sometimes I’m looking at it thinking well this will eventually be a really cool painting,” said Gallagher. So I kind of look at it in a couple of different views when I’m out looking.”

“... So you have to put yourself out there, says Gallagher. So I’m trying to, that’s my big goal this year.”

Contest winner “Seaside Boardwalk Acrylic” started with a photo Gallagher had taken while at the boardwalk. “I was there in the winter and it looked so magical,” she said. “It brings back many memories.”

The artwork Gallagher submitted for the art contest is a perfect depiction of the multi-step process she utilizes. According to Gallagher, while spending time at the boardwalk years ago she snapped a multitude of photos.

Fast forward to the aftermath of Superstorm Sandy during which pieces of that same boardwalk she photographed were now swept away by the Atlantic Ocean and the photographs were brought back to life.

“Actually the thing that spurred it on was once the Jet Star [roller coaster] fell into the ocean, my daughter was living out in California and she said, ‘Can you do a photo of the Jet Star out in the ocean?’ and I said, ‘Yeah, sure, I’ll do that,’ said Gallagher.

That painting fueled more beach and boardwalk pieces as Gallagher

scanned other images she had taken such as bumper cars, the ferris wheel, the Sawmill, Kohrs and more.

Another group she is a member of, the Toms River Artists Community [TRAC], is what ultimately led her to the Night and Day Art Contest. According to Gallagher, the contest details were posted on their member group page. Last year’s winner, John Delaney, is also a member of TRAC.

After learning about the competition she thought, “Let me just do this,” and entering certainly paid off. Gallagher admits she thinks oftentimes people are hesitant to enter contests because they think they aren’t going to win. But she notes that she has been finding more and more that if you don’t enter you’re never going to win anything.”

BEHIND THE COVER ART CONTEST

For the second annual art issue, Night & Day Magazine’s competition aimed to showcase original work by local artists to be featured on the cover of the first May issue.

With an art panel consisting of Jennifer O’Brien of Main Street Gallery in Manasquan, Norma Tolliver of Main Ave. Galleria in Ocean Grove, and Rebecca Szabo of the Belmar Arts Council, along with Night & Day staff, the magazine called all local artists to enter their original artwork in any medium.

Numerous unique and cover-worthy submissions were received from local artists and the art panel had the difficult task of choosing a winner.

HONORABLE MENTIONS



“Mermaid” by Samantha Stafford was done with watercolors in which she painted the mermaid with a calm expression on her face and adorned her arms and chest with scales to resemble armor. Her flowing hair is meant to represent waves and the textured background is reminiscent of water. Stafford uses vibrant colors and textures to create whimsical characters and worlds.



Maureen MacIntosh displays three pieces in her photographs that were created using epoxy resin, acrylic ink and oil paint. “Dark Wave” is the canvas and the small series is meant to create juxtaposition between an abstract oceanic environment to the defined idea of the wave itself. Her overall goal is to evoke an emotion of oceanic joy and inspiration.



“Shore Collage” by Ryan Wade is a depiction of things to see and do around the shore and was hand drawn with marker pen, then digitally colored. Wade notes pen and watercolor are his two favorite mediums.

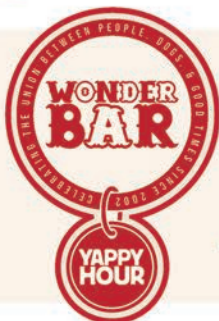

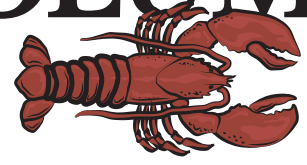

Manasquan River GROUP OF ARTISTS

The Manasquan River Group of Artists [MRGA] has been a long standing tradition in the local art community since it was originally formed in 1938. MRGA currently has more than one hundred members with a yearly schedule that includes exhibits at the Brielle, Wall and Point Pleasant Beach libraries as well as outdoor summer shows in Sea Girt, Bay Head, Spring Lake, Avon, Manasquan and Brielle.

FROM THE BEGINNING

According to MRGA history, Ida Wells Stroud who was a prominent artist and teacher resided in Herbertsville each summer with her daughter Clara who was an accomplished painter herself. Stroud held outdoor painting classes on the banks of the Manasquan River.

The history also explains that back in 1938 in the first week in November, the Strouds put together a small group of

artist friends and students to hold an art event in the town of Manasquan to support American Art Week.

C. Stroud described the event in notes saying, “Merchants on both sides of Main Street were signed up for paintings for their store windows. We decided to have a window walk and talk. When the appointed day came, we started off from the Woman’s Club down one side of the street and up the other – a crowd of us with friends and automobiles following – the occupants of which leaning far out of their windows. Each picture was viewed and commented upon... We returned to the Woman’s Club for tea.”

While initially MRGA was a small group of artists banded together for the purpose of promoting art in the community, enough interest was shown that officers were elected and group decided to be more active.

This included growing the group, moving meetings from members’ homes to the Spring Lake Community House followed by the Manasquan Women’s Club and finally settling in at the Curtis House in Brielle. In addition, membership was extended to include artists from a wider area.

The goal of its founders is still honored by the group today.

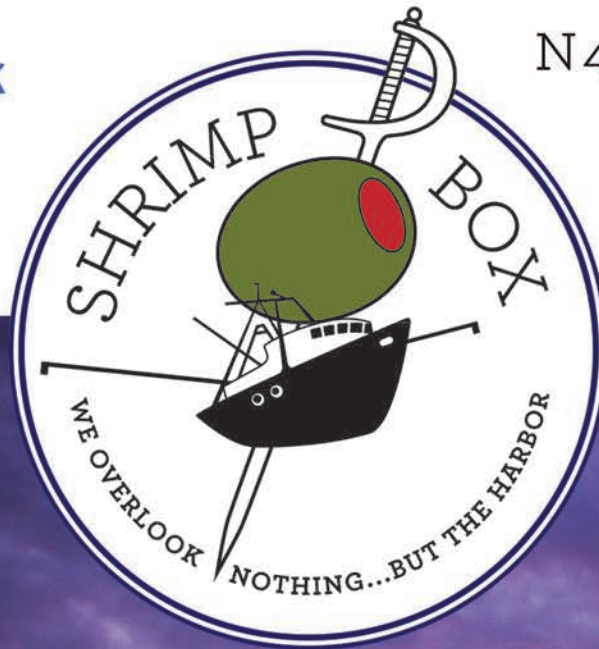

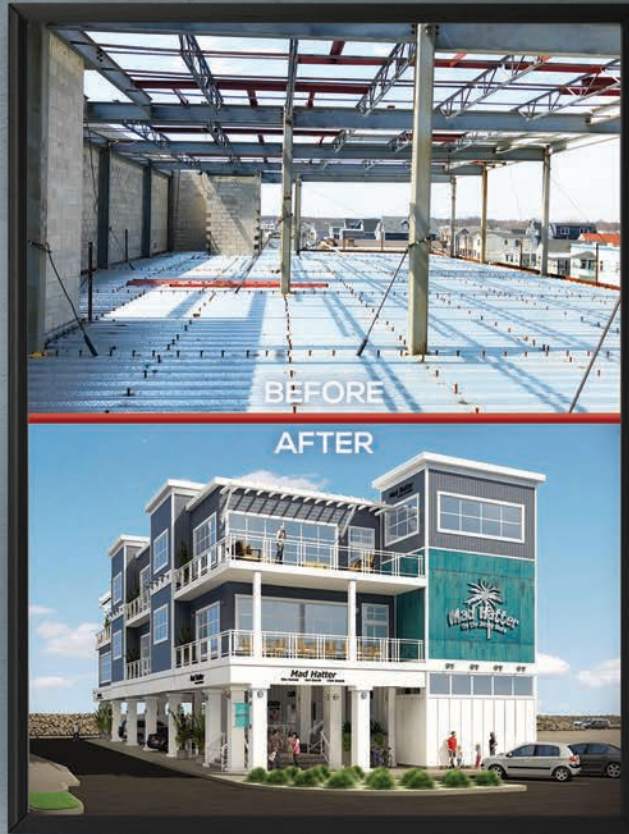

MASTER OF MIXOLOGY

IGOR SILVA - see him in action at Clark's Landing in Point Pleasant

O riginally from Brazil, Igor Silva made the move to the United States a little over two years ago. After living here for a couple months and teaching himself the English language, he landed a bartending job at Clark's Landing in Point Pleasant and has worked behind the bar ever since.

STARTING OUT

Silva has been a bartender for the past 11 years, starting out as an 18-year-old in Brazil to pay for his college education. After finishing college, Silva decided to stay with bartending.

"So I got a job at Bacardi and I had the chance to work with different brands such as Grey Goose, Martini, Bacardi Rum and Bombay and different brands in Brazil," he explained. "I decided to keep going and today it's my job, I like to say it's my profession, career."

Not only is bartending Silva's profession, it is a profession he takes extremely seriously.

"... I do like to use my knowledge as a professional not just like a side job," he said.

"This is what I do. I pay my bills with

that. It's cool. It's really different."

Working behind the bar at Clark's Landing, as opposed to a nightclub, is also a unique experience on its own, due in large part to the fact that the venue specializes in weddings and events. Silva said he came from a huge city, São Paulo in Brazil, which is similar to New York City. It's where you find the top bars and brands, but being at the shore has its own feel.

"We're by the shore so it's a little bit different," said Silva. "The concept of how we drink and how we enjoy is different as well."

"But what we do here, what I try to do here, is to bring that concept from top-shelf restaurants in the city to one night."

Silva explained that customers who come to a wedding and want a basic cocktail will, of course, get exactly what they want. But he can also offer specialty cocktails suited to their individual tastes.

"Whoever wants to try something different, that's my goal here," he said. "So people, they really enjoy, it's always a surprise."

MORE TO MIXOLOGY

Silva admits that he just likes to



make drinks, whatever they are, and doesn't have one special drink that he likes to make. However, he does have a personal favorite and that is Negroni, which is gin, sweet vermouth and campari.

According to Silva, when the first wave of guests for the cocktail hour arrive things get a little hectic behind the bar, but after that he can get to know what the customers really like.

"But then after that when we start to get a little bit slow here and we have time to talk to the customers and then we can offer something different," he said. "And then upstairs [in the reception room] is where I really have time to talk because after that they're sitting down, they have dinner, they're talking."

Whether it's putting his own spin on a popular cocktail or crafting up something totally different, Silva has mastered the art of mixology. His variation of a Moscow Mule starts with Makers Mark Bourbon followed by lemon juice, simple syrup and

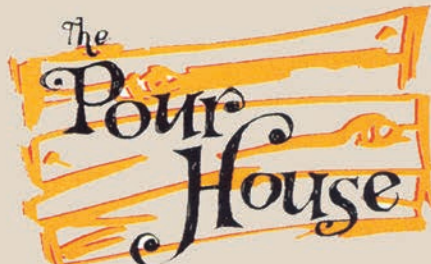
homemade fresh ginger foam that is floated on top. The Botanist is made with Grey Goose Le Poire, green seedless Thompson grapes, mint leaves, lemon juice, simple syrup and three dashes of peach bitters.

At Clark's Landing they strive for each and every event to come across like a one-night Broadway show where the servers act as performers. According to Silva, when he first applied for the job at Clark's they were looking for fly bartenders who flip the bottles behind the bar, which is what he had experience doing in Brazil.

"So I came here for that and when I got the job we tried to change the bar to this mixology concept," he said.

"That's what people like here, I think it's that experience and so far every night I have always one or two customers who make sure to come back to the bar and say, 'Hey, thank you, I really appreciate what you did and I love your drinks and you guys are awesome.'"

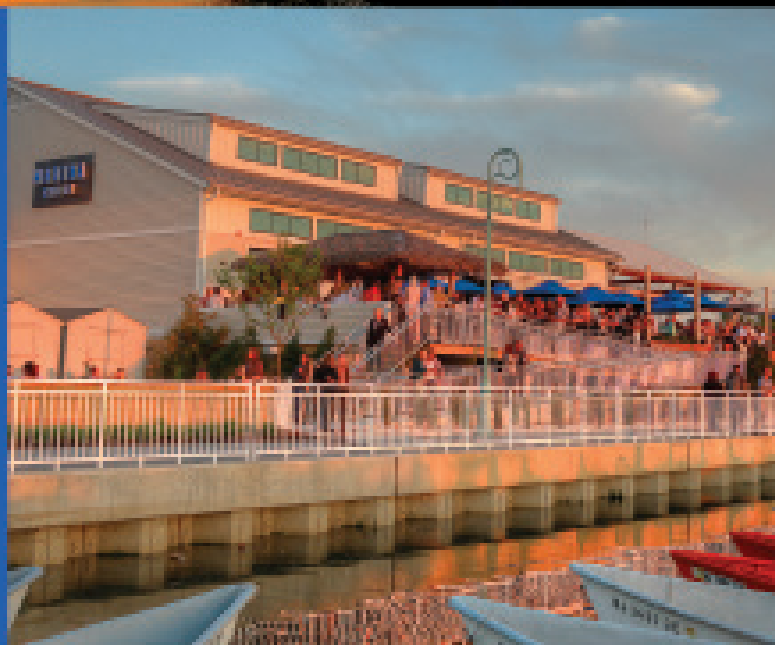
